State Finals-short reminders

- Entries MUST be postmarked no later than May 21st, 2008
- You MUST have a report card AND a school form at State Finals. NO Exceptions
- Stalls will be pre-assigned. Stall Office will be in center of barn closest to arena. See Michelle Clark
- You cannot arrive at facility before 3pm on Wed., May 28th.
- All contestants should plan to ride in Grand Entry if you can safely control your horse in this type of situation. Color themes are: **Friday-pink. Saturday- red/ white /blue. This is a change, please note.** Some contestants choose to decorate their horse.
- Go Round winners will take victory laps and receive awards immediately following event. Do Not leave if you are winning an event.
- National Team Information will be filled out after performance on Saturday.
- Be prepared to sign paperwork. BOTH PARENTS MUST sign paperwork. A deposit of \$200 will be required for motel/ camping. A stall fee of \$95 will be required for each horse you plan to take. Any stud stalls are \$150/each. **You MUST have membership card with you.**

- Contestants MUST be in dress code with sleeves rolled down and shirts tucked on 1 hour prior to rodeo. Back numbers MUST be worn at all times during Jr and Senior finals- regardless of attire.
- Stock will be drawn & posted 1 hour prior to each performance.
- Positions will be randomly drawn for barrel racing & pole bending.
- All other events will be drawn for the 1st go and work from last qualifying position to 1st qualifying position for the final go.
- We need volunteers to help with various duties at the State Finals please see Beth Kidd after rodeo to see if there is some way you can help.
- No horses can be tied to trailers overnight at the State Finals.
- You may need a pit crew if you are in multiple events. Please plan to have help if you have to change horses/saddles, etc.. between events. It is too far to run back to the stall or parking lot area. There is a warm up pen behind arena where your pit crew can wait.
- Points at the State Finals will be different. Point sheet is attached.
